Board Meeting Minutes

Monday, May 6, 2019

Attendees: Doug Rough, Leo Gilbert, Brian Magee, Ken Albinger, Antonio Skokos, and Jennifer Salem.

Doug reviewed the purpose of JNA.

David Wolbrecht returned the Grant Proposal for additional details. Antonio Skokos will meet with David Wolbrecht to establish what is required and add to the current proposal.

Planning for the Welcome event was discussed. Doug Rough will try to have flyers for the event printed for the June Board Meeting. Leo has contacted a middle school band director for entertainment ideas. We have approved \$200 each for two groups.

There was no new Treasury business. Rob Scarber received \$25 check for metal sign stakes.

Brian Magee said the Safety request for a path near Starbucks was approved and construction will be sometime next year. Last year's proposal for bike lane improvements will take place at the end of May. Leo Gilbert would like to propose protected bike lanes in Kirkland. Ken Albinger and Leo Gilbert may talk to the new city council candidates about this. Other safety ideas and other possible bike routes through Kirkland were discussed. No new ideas for Safety proposals will be taken forward until October.

Jennifer Salem will send a meeting announcement for the May General meeting to the email list. The Welcome event date will be added to the web site.

The next general meeting is May 13, 2019. There will be no meeting in July and meetings will resume in September.

Board meetings will be the first Monday of every month except July.

The agenda for the May JNA General Meeting was discussed.

Ken Albinger announced he would be resigning from the JNA board for next year.

The board was asked for any new business. Brian Magee mentioned that we may want to reopen the Neighborhood Plan to entice new people to volunteer. The Neighborhood Plan establishes neighborhood priorities and it has been several years since the last plan was put in place. The plan is about 52 pages and is available online.
